For the 19th edition of the UTMB® Mont-Blanc, the best trail runners in the world will meet in Chamonix to take part in one of the eight races. And this year the various opportunities to follow live promise to be even more immersive, with a new live platform, media partnerships and active social networks. Every trail enthusiast is invited to experience the World Trail Summit live from August 22 to 28 on live.utmb.world.

The new platform, live.utmb.world, will bring together all the different live tools, acting as the main hub of the UTMB Mont-Blanc. From Monday August 22 to Wednesday August 24, you will find the results and detailed statistics of the races that take place at the beginning of the week (PTL®, MCC, TDS®, ETC, YCC). And from Thursday 25 to Sunday 28 August, the 3 key races of the week (OCC, CCC®, UTMB®) will be broadcast live.

Introduction of the race favorites, starts, follow-up with the race leaders, key info about the race, unique insights and, of course, the winners finishing, will keep the live action coming, with commentary by experts in 6 languages: English, French, Spanish, Chinese, Japanese and new this year, Thai.
